| Citation | 1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Disasters) (Compulsory Assistance) Order, 19 . |
| Power to Call for assistance etc. | 2. A gazetted police officer or subordinate police officer, a person mentioned in the Schedule hereto, or any person duly authorized by such person. may call upon an adult person to render such assistance or to perform such service as may appear to him to be necessary or expedient for the purpose of dealing with the emergency and may give directions as to the manner of the assistance or service. |
| Schedule | |
| Inter-pretation | 3. For the purposes of this Order “perform such “service” includes the use of any vehicle, implement or tool in the possession of any adult person called upon under paragraph 2. |
| Refusal To assist | 4. Any person who without reasonable excuse refuses to render assistance or to perform a service when called upon under paragraph 2 is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for a term of one month or to both. |
